

The Government of West Bengal set up an expert committee on December 31, 1998, under the Chairmanship of Ashesh Prasad Mitra, Eminent Scientist to explore the necessity and scope for establishment of an Engineering / Technology University in the state of West Bengal.

The University came into operation formally with the assumption of the office of the first Vice Chancellor in January 15, 2001 as a sequel to the promulgation of THE WEST BENGAL UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY ACT, 2001, under West Bengal Act XV of 2000 passed by the West Bengal Legislature. The University started its academic programme, from July, 2001 following a Notification from the Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal in June, 2001 through the affiliation of Engineering and Management Institutions / Colleges and has entered the eighteen year of its functioning. The University is included in Section 2F and also in Section 12B of UGC and recipient of UGC Grant.



About AICTE

The All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) is the statutory body and a national-level for under Department council technical education, Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development. Established in November 1945 first as an advisory body and later on in 1987 given statutory status by an Act of Parliament, AICTE is responsible for proper planning and coordinated development of the technical education and management education system in India. The AICTE accredits postgraduate and graduate programs under specific categories at Indian institutions as per its charter. It is assisted by 10 Statutory Boards of Studies, namely, UG Studies in Eng. & Tech., PG and Research in Eng. and Tech., Management Studies, Vocational Education, Technical Education, Pharmaceutical Education, Architecture, Hotel Management and Catering Technology, Information Technology, Town and Country Planning.



The AICTE has its new headquarters building in Delhi on the Nelson Mandela Road, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi, 110 067, which has the offices of the chairman, vice-chairman and the member secretary, plus it has regional offices at Kanpur, Chandigarh, Gurgaon, Mumbai, Bhopal, Vadodara, Kolkata, Guwahati, Bangalore, Hyderabad, Chennai and Thiruvananthapuram.

In its 25 April 2013 judgement the Supreme Court said "as per provisions of the AICTE Act and University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, the council has no authority which empowers it to issue or enforce any sanctions on colleges affiliated with the universities as its role is to provide guidance and recommendations. Subsequently AICTE was getting approval from the Supreme court to regulate technical colleges on a year to year basis till January 2016, when AICTE got blanket approval for publishing the Approval Process Handbook and approve technical colleges including management for the session 2016-17 and in all future sessions."

About Vocational Course

The AICTE has launched a scheme on skills development based higher education as part of college/university education, leading to Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) Degree with multiple exits such as Diploma/Advanced Diploma under the NSQF. The B.Voc. Programme is focused on universities and colleges providing undergraduate studies which would also incorporate specific job roles and their NOSs along with broad based general education.

This would enable the graduates completing B.Voc. to make a meaningful knowledge participation in accelerating India's economy by gaining appropriate employment, becoming entrepreneurs and creating appropriate knowledge.

Course Objective

- To provide judicious mix of skills relating to a profession and appropriate content of General Education.
- To ensure that the students have adequate knowledge and skills, so that they are work ready at each exit point of the programme.
- To provide flexibility to the students by means of pre-defined entry and multiple exit points.
- To integrate NSQF within the undergraduate level of higher education in order to enhance employability of the graduates and meet industry requirements. Such graduates apart from meeting the needs of local and national industry are also expected to be equipped to become part of the global workforce.
- To provide vertical mobility to students coming out of 10+2 with vocational subjects.

All the courses are having **40**% of **theory** classes and **60**% of **practical** sessions. The course curriculum is fully at par with **NSFQ** framework.

- 5. Caution money is refundable at the end of the programme / transfer / discontinuation after adjusting for any damage of property / fines /penalties dues etc. without interest.
- 6. Any late payment of fees, is subject to late fees as decided by management from time to time.
- 7. **Timing**: The College will remain open for both shifts from 9.00 am to 8.00 pm Monday to Friday and Saturday from 10.00 am to 5.00 pm except holidays. - 12. Nomenclature of degrees may be renamed as per UGC/MAKAUT/Affiliating Body norms; IMSBS have no role in it & students have to accept that.
- 13. Students suffering year lag or back log have to pay 10% of the semester fees for each semester where he or she is reappearing for the exam in addition to exam fees, as per MAKAUT norms.
- 14. Students may have to stitch additional sets of uniform, if the complementary, set is not lasting for the entire duration of the programme or found uncomfortable, and IMSBS will not bear such cost. Alteration & maintenance of uniform is students' responsibility.
- 15. IMSBS may impose Rs. 100/- or Rs. 50 /- as DD handling charges from students for each semester Fees/Examination Fees if necessary.

General Guidelines

- 16. Students discontinuing, course must return Tab. Uniforms and Books in workable condition, otherwise caution money will not refunded.
- 17. Part time Student / Training Programme students shall have same rules & regulation as applicable.
- 18. **Library Rules**: Students are entitled to get as many number of books as subjects at a time. All books issued to students must be rotated after 7 days of issue. Tenure of possession of any book can be extended up to another seven days on reissuing. Otherwise, a fine shall be imposed from the 8th day. If the book is not returned within 15 days, a further fine will be charged from the 16th day. Books may be reissued only once, after which it must be returned to the library.

The rate of fine shall be Re. 1/- per book per day for first seven days (i.e. 8th day to 15th day). If books are not returned within next 7 days, a fine of Re. 2/- per day per book shall be imposed (16th day onwards).

After reissuing, if book is not returned within next seven days, a fine of Re. 1/- will be applicable from 16th day for the next seven days and thereafter the fine will be Re. 2/- per book per day.

During inter semester break, students can keep maximum 2 books for a period of 1 month without fine.

Fine will not be adjusted with caution money for students. Instant cash payment will have to be made.

No books will be issued without one's own library card.

Research scholars can issue four books at a time by rotation throughout the year. Books can be issued for a period of 1 month and thereafter reissued for 2 months. Rate of fine is same as above.

- 19. **Field Trip / Industry Visit**: Students shall be provided with complimentary picnic only in the 1st year of their course. Thereafter, if they wish to participate in the same they must pay for the event as decided by the management. As per the requirement of specific courses field trips, industry visits etc. will be arranged during the course. Students of PG programs must pay the required amount for the trip along with 15% service charges.
- 20. Education Loan is available from any bank for all programmes as all our programmes are duly recognized by renowned State University, Maulana Abul Kalam Azad University of Technology (MAKAUT).

Rules & Regulations

- 6. Students are not allowed to use Cell phones in the class, cell phones are strictly debarred in the examination hall.
- 7. Acceptance or refusal of admission is a 100% prerogative of the institution.
- 8. Students will have to pay the fees as revised by the University from time to time. Fees once paid, is not refundable under any circumstances. No extra fees will be charged in the middle of a session, so far as IMSBS fees are concerned.

- 13. Minimum of 80% of attendance is required to appear for exam and qualify for placement assistance.


